Let's Play A Game!

The Butterfly



How to play:

- Place three jandals (or shoes) on the floor, each a foot –length apart, in a line.
- Name someone 'the butterfly'.
- Make everyone stand in a single file line, with space for a run-up. The butterfly should be the last person in the line.
- Starting at the front of the line, send each person off one at a time. They have to step once in between each shoe.
- Once they have made it through they should line up on the other side. When it is the butterflies turn, they do the same except wherever their last foot lands on the other side of the last shoe, is where the last shoe should be moved to. This spaces out the shoes thus making it harder for the next player to 'make it'.
- Repeat the process and move the last shoe each time the butterfly lands.
- If you fail to take only one step in between each of the shoes, you are out.
